Mozo Experts Choice Awards Broadband Plans 2023

This is the fourth year running that we've gathered together countless pieces of information and applied our methodology to find the leading broadband plans in Australia.

Product providers don't pay to be in the running with our awards, and we don't play favourites. Our judges base their decision on hard-nosed calculations of value to the consumer, using Mozo's extensive product database and research capacity. We identify the most important features of each product, group each product into like-for-like comparisons, and then calculate which are better value than most or offer market-leading features.

This report lists the winners and explains the judging methodology for our 2023 Broadband awards.



Broadband Provider Of The Year



Flip took out wins in 5 categories this year, and this is the second time in a row they have been chosen as our Broadband Provider of the Year. No other provider matches the excellent value across a wide range of services that Flip does.

Standard Broadband (NBN 25)

For people with modest internet needs the NBN 25 speed tier is often enough, and can be a great value option.

Standard Plus Broadband (NBN 50)

The NBN 50 speed offers a good balance between cost and providing useful speeds for households with moderate to high download requirements.

Fast Broadband (NBN 100

While faster speed broadband plans are becoming more common, the NBN 100 tier offers plenty of power for large families or other households with heavy internet usage.

Super Fast Broadband (NBN 250)

Plans with speeds higher than 100 are becoming more common as people demand more of their internet connection. For this category the judges considered plans with a download speed of 250 Mbps.

5G Home Broadband

With 5G coverage rolling out to more and more Australian homes every month, we examined pricing of advertised 5G home broadband plans and awarded these plans as offering best value.

Cost Calculation

We calculated the minimum cost of each plan over a 24 month period, taking into account:

- Set up costs
- Monthly charges
- Introductory discounts

Contract Options

We included NBN plans with contracts where they were an equivalent cost or cheaper than the no contract alternatives in each speed category.

For the 'Contract' plan options, we calculated the cost of all contract plans over 24 months.

• For the 24 month cost, if a provider did not offer a 24 months contract then we took the longest contract available and calculated the cost of remaining beyond the contract term on a month-to-month basis.

Download Limits

In previous years we have considered plans with download limits for some categories. They have become less common and plans with download limits are no longer eligible to win in our awards.

Delivery Technology

Where price varied depending on delivery technology we collected fibre-to-the-node and fibre-to-the-curb as the cheapest and most representative options available to the majority of consumers. Prices for other connection options may vary.

We also collected pricing and plan information for 5G home broadband internet.

Advertised Speed

A provider must disclose its typical evening speed on their website or in publicly available fact sheets to be eligible for an award. Where the typical evening speed was not disclosed the plan was not eligible for awards, except for the 5G Home Broadband. The ACCC has said that typical evening speeds should not be less than 60% of the top speed available on a plan, so any that were less were not eligible to win.

'Basic' plans offering a 12 Mbps speed were not considered in these awards.

How many winners are there?

We typically aim to award the top 10% of products in each category. The judges may use their discretion to adjust the cutoff up or down as necessary after examining the difference between products at the margin.

Broadband Provider of the Year

To find the best provider of internet services overall, we reviewed the winners of the individual categories to identify those that had won most awards. We then compared how each had performed in every category that makes up these awards. This process found that one provider performed better in the majority of categories and they were named our Broadband Provider of the Year.

What products do we consider?

In carrying out the Mozo Experts Choice Awards for NBN broadband services we assessed 143 retailers of home connections listed on the NBNCo website in March 2023. Retailers servicing a limited geographic area were excluded, as were plans for businesses. There were 76 retailers that met our criteria and these are listed in the Appendix. Additionally we collected 5G home broadband plans from 7 providers.

The information collection was conducted between 15 March and 8 April 2023. To be considered for inclusion in these awards all information considered must be readily available on the retailer's website or provided when asked via online chat, phone or email.

We aim to include most providers in the market in the Mozo Experts Choice Awards. However, not every product on the market will be included in our review. Any product we review must be available in the market at the time of our analysis.

How we manage conflicts of interest

Mozo Experts Choice Awards are based on objective verifiable facts and analysis wherever possible, and any assumptions made are set out in this report. Mozo's research team analyses product data and determines the winners in each Mozo Experts Choice category without reference to Mozo's sales or commercial functions.

A provider can participate in the Mozo Experts Choice Awards free of charge.

Mozo charges a licence fee to providers should they wish to use the Mozo Experts Choice Awards badges in their own marketing activities. Mozo may also offer promotional packages that may be purchased.

Mozo Experts Choice awards are awarded irrespective of a product provider's commercial relationship with Mozo.
